












# **E-Learning Course for European Peer Counsellors**

The peer counsellor training in inclusive tourism is now available as an E-Learning course in all partner languages plus an English version on the moodle platform of the VSBI e.V.!

The course consists of 12 modules which cover various topics like the history of the independent living movement, self-experience, and self-assessment as a peer counsellor as well as methods in peer-counselling and adult education.

Due to the modular structure of the course trainers and trainees can choose with which modules and in which order they want to work. Additionally, the course not only enables individual online learning but also blended-learning and face-to-face learning opportunities. That

is why, the individual and different needs and knowledge of trainers and trainees can be addressed in an adequate way.

Especially during the Covid-19 pandemic the online learning opportunity is helpful to secure the further training in inclusive tourism. The training course presents a range of learning materials like working documents, presentations, and videos. All videos are accessible.
